COMPUTERIZATION OF LAND RECORDS-MISSING MUTATIONS
(PART SARKAR)

Under section 41- A of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1967 and rule 37-B of the Punjab Land Revenue Rules, 1968, the latest edition of periodical record of an estate is computerized alongwith mutations mentioned in the remarks column of Register Haqdaran Zamin currently under use with the Patwari of the estate. Sub-rules (8) and (9) of rule 37-B ibid provide and under:

(8) The Collector of the District shall cause to be maintained a list of all the mutations or fard badr sanctioned after the start of preparation of computerized record in an estate.

(9) After the data entry for preparation of computerized record of an estate under sub-rule (1) has been completed, the Collector of the District shall supply the list of mutations or fard badr, along with all such mutations or fard badr (*part sarkar*) to the Service Centre In-charge, who shall cause these mutations or fard badr to be entered in the computerized record."

It has been brought to the notice of the Board of Revenue Punjab that foils of certain mutations (*Part Sarkar*), mentioned in the remarks column of Registers Haqdaran Zamin of some estates are not traceable in Tehsil Offices and presumably the same were not deposited by the Circle Revenue Officers concerned in the Tehsil Offices.

You are therefore requested to call upon all Revenue Officers (Assistant Collector 1st Grade/Assistant Collector 2nd Grade) who remained posted in any tehsil in district under your control during the last seven years to indicate the period of their posting in each revenue circle (name of the circle/tehsil to be mentioned) during the said period and also furnish, within seven days, certificate to the effect that foils of all mutations decided by them were duly deposited in the Tehsil Office concerned. If any foils of mutations remain to be deposited by them they should deposit the same within seven days positively. If any Revenue Officer fails to comply with your directions in the matter, he should be proceeded against under the Punjab Employees' Efficiency Discipline Accountability Act, 2006.
